Evapotranspiration Analysis in Flow System QuantificationCraig L. Westenburg

Craig's talk will be a generic discussion of how Evapotranspiration (ET) determination helps define water budgets in the arid West. His discussion will include: 1. What ET is; 2. Why ET quantification is important part of the water budget; 3. How ET is measured and ET discharge is quantified; and 4. The future direction of ET quantification.

Speaker's Background & Education

Craig Westenburg graduated from the University of Arizona with a Bachelors degree in watershed management. From 1977 to 1979 he worked as a hydrologic technician in southern California. After California, from 1979 to 1984, he worked as a hydrologist for the Bureau of Land Management in Battle Mt., Nevada. Since 1984 he has been a hydrologist for the United States Geological Survey in southern Nevada.
