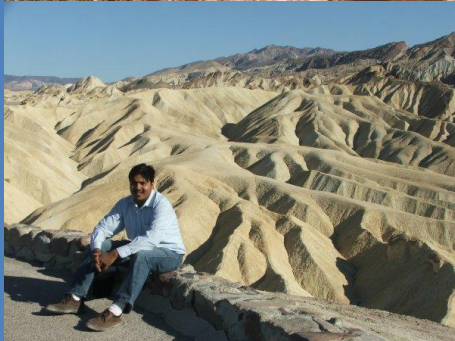
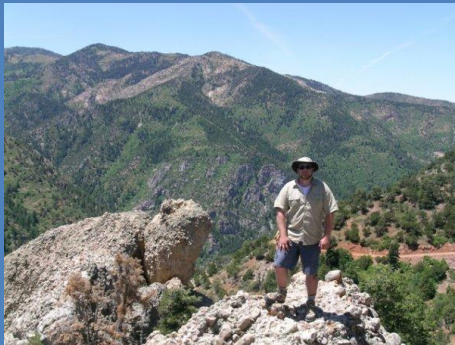
Background:
