



# The 2011 UNLV GeoSymposium Poster Guidelines

## Prepare Your Poster

Each presenter will be provided with an easel and a poster board that will accommodate a 3-foot-high by 3-foot-wide poster.

- The presentation must cover the material described in the abstract.
- At the top of the poster, indicate the title and authors.
- Prepare your poster so that all images, charts, etc. can easily be read from 2 meters away. Paragraph and figure caption text should be AT LEAST 24-point font, and headers AT LEAST 36 point font.
- The poster should be well organized and self-explanatory.
- Be prepared to give a 5- to 7-minute discussion of your research to those who visit your poster.

## Set Up Your Poster/Give Your Presentation

When you enter the Blasco Event Wing of the Foundation Building, look for the poster board that displays your presentation number.

- Posters should be set up between 8:30 and 9:00 am. Clips will be available to hang up posters.
- Posters must remain up until the close of the poster session. The awards are presented at 3:45 pm and you may take your poster down at approximately 4:00 pm or after the awards ceremony.
- Please make sure your presentation number is clearly visible on your poster board.
- Students who are first authors must be present for the entire session in which their poster is presented.

## Remove Your Poster

Posters should be removed between 4:00 and 4:15 pm.
