

Nevada has physical safety issues concerning abandoned mining features that exist throughout the state. We advocate for the avoidance of these features and help save lives by educating the public about the dangers of abandoned mines. We need YOU to help us inventory and secure these features by conducting field inspections and constructing fences or postings to warn of the dangers present. You will see many of Nevada's historic mining districts and enjoy the summer outdoors, but don't be fooled, it's hard work!





Requirements

- Possess a valid driver's license
- Can work in all weather conditions
- Capable of lifting at least 50 lbs and hiking over uneven desert terrain and conditions
- Up to 13 weeks of employment, mostly Mon-Fri with some longer weeks
- Expect regular and overtime wages, as field days will often be 12 hours and weekly totals may exceed 40 hrs/wk
- Job is based out of Carson City for the duration of employment, the Division will not cover relocation costs
- Must be able to work well alone, with a partner and in small groups
- Must be able to work in remote areas
- Must be willing to camp in remote areas lacking amenities
